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To install the CR2032 Battery, use a screwdriver to unscrew the battery cover counter-clockwise. Remove the cover to reveal the battery compartment.



Insert the CR2032 battery positive side (+) out. Re-install the battery cover and tighten by turning the screwdriver clockwise.

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Manual Adjustment: Press the "+" button to raise the brightness or the "-" button to lower the brightness.

Sleep Mode: The RISE is equipped with Sleep Mode. which is set by default to turn the dot off after 2 minutes of inactivity.

Auto Revive: Sight will automatically turn on with

Manually turning the sight OFF/ON: Hold the "-" button for 3 seconds to turn the sight off manually. (*sight will fade out when turning off). This will override the Auto Revive feature and keep the sight turned off until manually turned on. Press either the "-" or "+" button to turn the sight back on.

Brightness Lock Out: Hold the "+" button for 3 seconds (*dot will flash) to lock the sight. This will lock the sight at its current brightness setting and override the "sleep mode" feature. Hold the "+" button for 3 seconds (*dot will flash) to turn off the "lock out" feature.

High/Low Flash: The dot will flash 3 times to indicate that you are at either the highest brightness setting (10) or lowest brightness setting (1).

Recall Mode: Sight will automaticity remember the last brightness setting when turned on or off.

Mounting (Pistol)

Mounting on a Pistol

Prior to mounting the RISE, ensure that your pistol slide is cut or is compatible with the DeltaPoint pro footprint.

Step 1. Attach the RISE to your slide or adapter plate by using the provided screws and torx wrench.

Ensure that your RISE is properly seated on the slide

Sighting in

Once the RISE has ben properly mounted, it is time to siaht it in.

At the range, take a shot down range and adjust the elevation and windage (shown on the next page) until your point of aim coincides with your point of impact.

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Repeat this process until you're satisfied with your

Elevation and Windage Adjustments



Use a flathead key to make elevation adjustments to your red dot's position. As indicated, counter-clockwise moves your Point of Impact UP. 1 Click = 1 MOA



Use a flathead key to make windage adjustments to your red dot's position. As indicated, counter-clockwise moves your Point of Impact RIGHT. 1 Click = 1 MOA
